

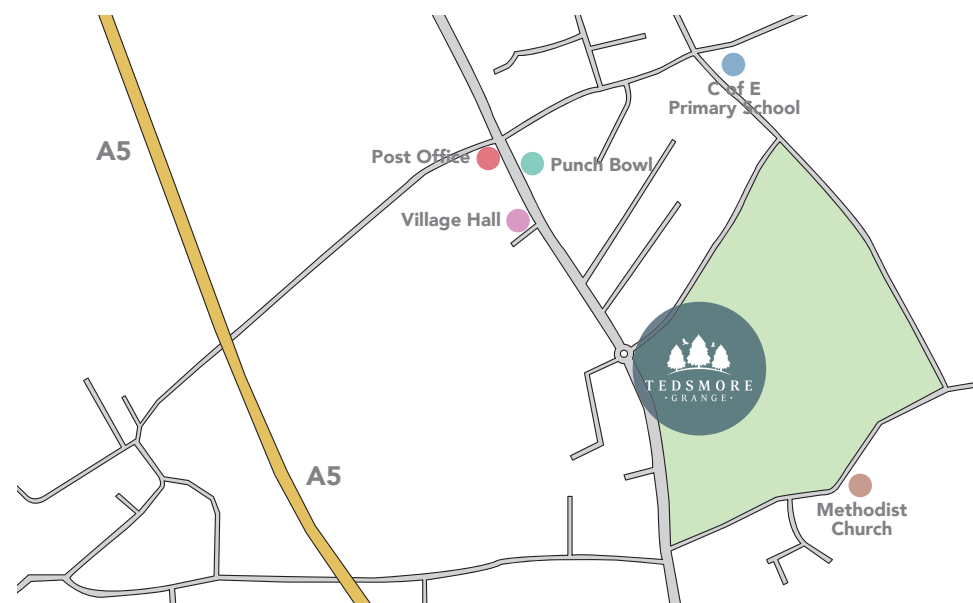


Tedsmore Grange is a collection of 35 stylish country homes set in a unique parkland setting, all with large gardens and generous room proportions.

To spend a day strolling around the shops head to Shrewsbury, which is just 13 miles from Tedsmore Grange. Independent retailers outnumber big chains by almost half. Visit endless boutiques and quirky independents in this medieval county town.

Days Out

For a great family day out why not visit Park Hall Countryside Experience just six miles away? Here you can enjoy a full day of events including Meet and Feed the farm animals, Pets Corner and tractor and trailer rides.

The British Ironworks Centre is also on your doorstep, just two miles away, with free entry seven days-a-week. The Centre is home to a splendid collection of magnificent animal sculptures from the majestic Silver Back Gorilla made out of 40,000 spoons, to an assortment of more familiar favourites from the animal kingdom. A busy events calendar, keeps visitors entertained throughout the year.
